Although additional equipment will be needed to properly outfit the Home Economics Room, Mr. Joblin and myself would like to have the following:-

- 2 large cutting tables - 6' x 3½'
- 2 sewing machines
- 2 electric irons
- 2 pair cutting sheers
- 1 dozen smaller scissors
- 2 folding ironing boards
- 4-plate electric range with oven
- cooking, baking and canning utensils
- Dishes and cutlery for 6 individuals
- 4 sturdy tables with large electric plate attached - each to accommodate 2 pupils
- 6 or 7 cubic feet electric refrigerator ?
- Built in cupboard

As the Home Economics Room must serve as an auditorium we should like to have a quantity - number depending on the size - of

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folding benches for seating accommodation.

The grounds of the various schools become overgrown with weeds etc. during the summer. To keep these grounds under proper care I would suggest the purchase of a Garden Tractor with cutting-bar attached. As this implement could serve other various purposes it is a question as to what division would purchase it should it be approved. I am suggesting the matter to Mr. Pratt, under separate cover, and perhaps some action may be taken.

There are also a few items to be completed in connection with the school itself. These are things which could not be done owing to the winter weather and as soon as our labour is available we should like to request permission to have these things done.
