Industrious work by the pupils of the Shingwauk School was rewarded when several hundred guests attended the tea and bazaar held at the school on Saturday afternoon. The children prepared for the event long in advance, making tickets, posters and items for the bazaar tables.

Aprons and blouses, sewn by the Girls' Auxiliary, were featured at one table, and a woodwork display was made by the boys in their manual training class. Interesting Indian articles were due to the efforts of the young Brownies. The Church Boys' League was responsible for a fishing pond, which proved to be very successful. There was also an appealing display of homemade bake goods and sewing articles made by the W.A. of the Shingwauk.

The matron of the school, Miss A. M. Grant, received the guests at the door. Bronze and yellow mums decorated the head table, and those pouring tea were Mrs. J. S. Smedley, Mrs. W. B. Jennings, Mrs. H. M. Monteith, Mrs. R. P. Laurence, Miss L. Haines, and Mrs. Anderson of Garden River.
