Don:

I am enclosing a copy of a design for a revised website for the Ingle pictures which I have sent to Celia. If you are willing to see that it is put in place on the AUC website over the summer, I will drop my objection to your use of the pictures.

As you can see the outline is pretty straightforward and simple aside from rearranging some of the pictures in the last section <u>Shingwauk and Beyond</u>. The new design arranges the pictures in a chronological order, starting with the earliest ones and moving finally to the 50th wedding anniversary prints.

<u>The Beginning</u> take the three earliest pictures and sets them up as an introductory file. <u>Training in Chapleau</u> adds the two Chapleau pictures (still numbered 10 and 11) from your <u>Photo Essay</u> file. <u>The Fort George Years</u> combines the relevant pictures from the <u>Photo Essay</u> and <u>People of Fort George</u> and merges them together with only a little reordering; the main change here is renumbering them. <u>Shingwauk and Beyond</u> traces my parents together from the start to the 50th anniversary. It requires some rearranging since it brings together pictures from the <u>Photo Essay</u>, <u>Children of Shingwauk</u>, <u>Miscellaneous</u> and <u>Epiloque - Moose Factory</u> files.

I've corrected the identification where it needed it and added a few details you didn't have. I've also added a few details where the identification on the pictures is insufficient. Your website is not my books -- it carries none of the detail covered in them. Therefore your identification should always adequately describe what people are seeing since that's all they have to go by.

Additionally, your biases show where you list names of students but not of staff. This is not the way to convince people, including potential sources of funding, that you represent a centre for healing.

I think removing the two pictures I've designated is only fair given what has happened.

I have told Celia that I will wait until September for the return of the canoe. However, it is a line-in-the-sand issue with me. If it isn't returned I will go to the national media and ask through them why it is missing. Please have another look in the basement -- you are the custodian.
