The time and location for the Indian Residential School Claims symposium in Williams Lake is Tuesday, October 3 in the Gibraltar Room at the Cariboo Memorial Complex between 3 p.m. and 6 p.m., says organizer Simon Moses.

Admission is free and everyone is welcome, he says.

Keynote speakers for the event are Kamloops aboriginal lawyers Len Marchant Jr. and Michelle Good who will be on hand to answer questions and provide up-to-date information on the agreements between the governments, churches and First Nations survivors.

The compensation package for native people who attended residential school is \$10,000 for the first year and \$3,000 for each additional year.

But there are other options that native people can discus with the lawyers, Moses says.
