

The federal government has agreed to compensate aboriginals who went through the residential school system with compensation. Common experience payouts have been sent out and will be followed by compensation for specific offences.

Adrienne Merrick said she did not have quite as bad an experience in residential schools as

older generations, but said it was a good thing to have the eagle statue ceremony take place.

"It's very memorable for everybody and closure for a lot of people," Adrienne said.
