

"We don't have a location for it yet . . . we'd like it to be someplace in Bruce Grey and in a natural setting. It would include a

memorial garden for the children who died while at residential school," said Brubacher.

Brubacher said he saw a documentary recently that claimed as many as half of the children sent to residential schools died while attending the schools.

He said the lodge would offer healing programs for survivors and their families and ways to bring together people from all cultures.

"It will provide a place where their families can pray and the green growing things can represent transformation of pain to new life," Brubacher said.
