lawful money of ten cents now paid by the said part of

(the receipt whereof is hereby by him acknowledged by  
the said part of the first part Do Grant unto

and receipt for ever

~~All and singular the certain parcel or tract of land  
and premises situate lying and being~~

and his successors in trust for the use of the said  
Provincial Institution called and known as the  
"Disengaged Home" All and singular these certain  
parcels or tracts of land and premises situate lying  
and being in the first range or concession of the said  
Town of Saint St. Marie and may be described as the  
West half of Park lot number one and the whole of  
Park lot number two containing together ninety and  
one half acres be the same more or less To Have and to Hold  
unto
