GREETING:

KNOW ALL the lands hereinafter described are vested in Us in right of Canada.

AND WHEREAS the said lands are not required for public purposes, and under and by virtue of the statutes in that behalf and pursuant to authority duly granted by Our Governor in Council, the said lands or the interest therein that is or may be vested in Us for the uses of Canada have been disposed of to The Incorporated Syndic of the Diocese of Algoma, of the city of Sault Ste. Marie, in the Province of Ontario, hereinafter called the grantee, at and for the price or sum of One Dollar.

NOW KNOW YE that in do by these Presents grant, convey and assure unto the grantee and its successors, all AND WHOLLY: -

Those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Sault Ste. Marie, in the District of Algoma and being composed of parts of the west 1/2 of Park Lot 1 and parts of the east 1/2 of Park Lot 2, in the First Concession of Park Lots in the Township of St. Mary (now in the said City of Sault Ste. Marie) containing a total area of 30.856 acres, be the more more or less, and which parcels or tracts of land may be more particularly described as follows:

Being those portions of said Park Lot 1 designated as Part 2, 3, 4, and Part 11 and being those portions of said Park Lot 2, designated as Part 1 and Part 10 on a Reference Plan of survey deposited in the Registry Office for the said District of St. John as plan IR-1222.

Reserving a right-of-way for all persons lawfully entitled thereto over, along and upon the strip of land designated as Part 3, on the said Reference Plan of survey.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said lands unto the grantee and its successors, forever; saving, excepting and reserving unto us, Our Heirs and Successors, the free use, passage and enjoyment of, in, over and upon all navigable waters that now are or may be hereafter found on or under or flowing through or upon any part of the said lands.
