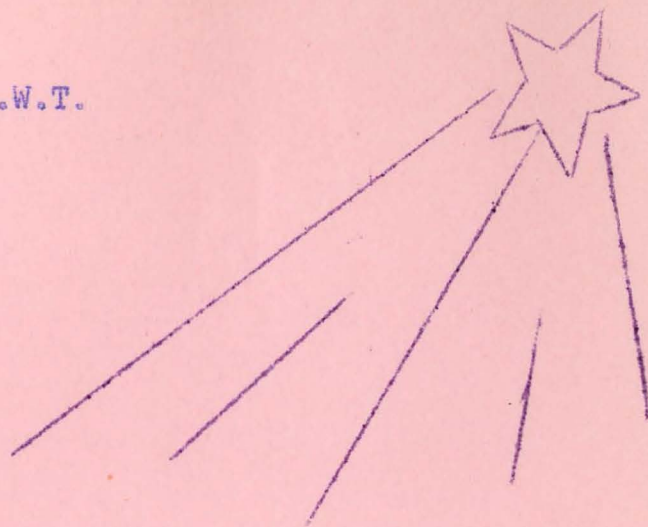


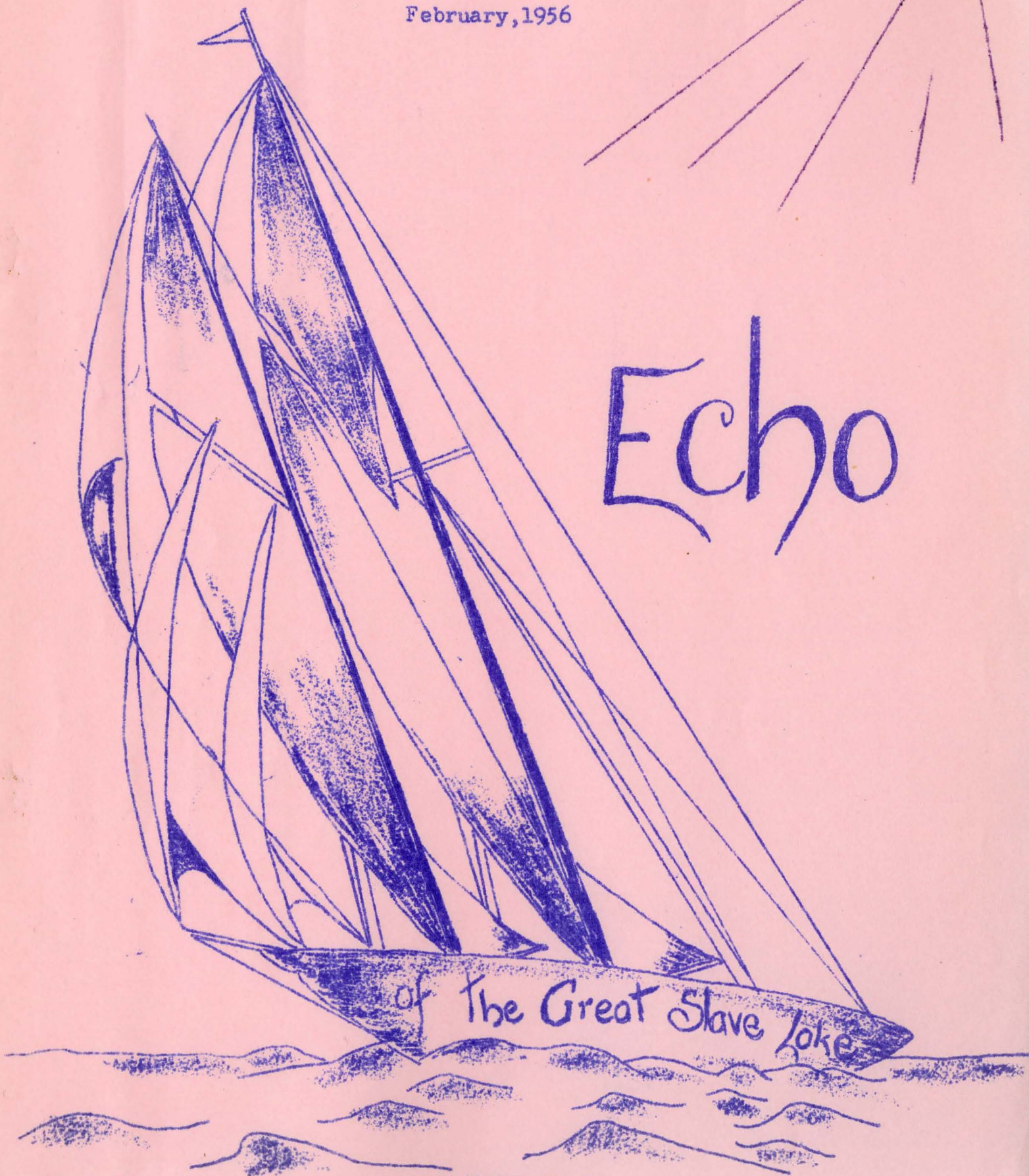

DEAR PARISHIONERS,

I take this first opportunity to tell you how glad I am to be once more with you. To discharge my duties well, I count again on your co-operation and the help of your prayers. I was sent to you, to preach to you the Gospel and CHRIST the Crucified as says Saint Paul.

To prepare you better for Easter Sunday, I wish to convey to you, today the Message of Lent.

It is not enough to understand how much Jesus suffered for love of us. Judas understood it, Pilate understood it, the executioners understood it far better than we. But they lost the significance of it all. We must not lose its significance. We must know that the lesson of Calvary is the lesson of God's love. Standing beside the cross of Jesus with Mary His mother, and then looking upon our crucifix, how can we ever doubt that God loves us. God loves us with an infinite love; and that is why we are going to accept and to return His love by preferring loyalty to Him to a passing pleasure.

No longer will the thirty pieces of silver make us traitors to our loving God. That is why we are going to carry our own cross through this life, knowing that even though the cross be heavy, even though it causes us to stagger and at times to fall beneath its weight, even though it leads to a Calvary and to a very crucifixion by way of suffering and sacrifice and hardship, it leads also to Jesus our Saviour, it leads also to heaven and to eternal happiness that God in His infinite love has prepared for us, it leads to the time when we ourselves, transfigured after death, shall see God face to face.

As in Gethsemani, the people and the sins of the world are present to our Saviour's mind, from the Cross He sees them all. He sees you and me and our sins that we commit now, that were present then, adding to His torments by the rejection of His love. But, if our sins were all present to Jesus in His passion and death, so also were our good works present to Him to comfort Him during these terrible hours. Jesus is God, and for God there is no time. Everything is present to God. Is it not then good for us to be in memory with Jesus on mount Calvary? Think of it now, so that you may rise from the dead on the last day.

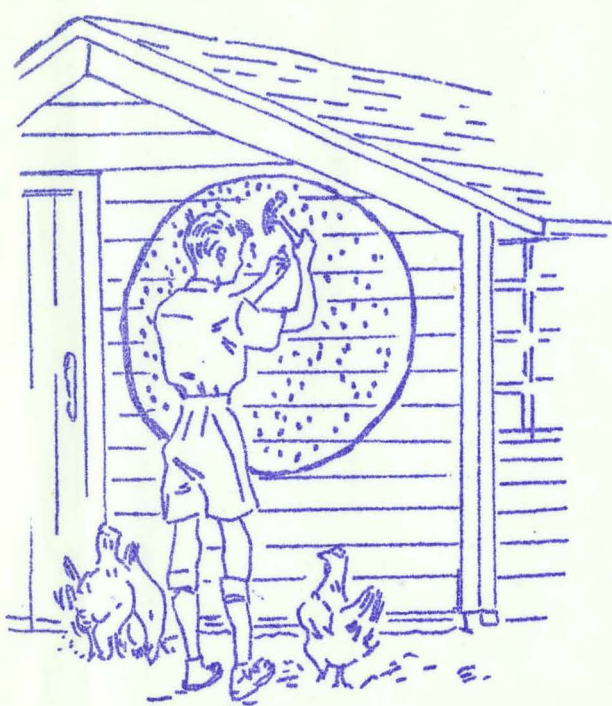

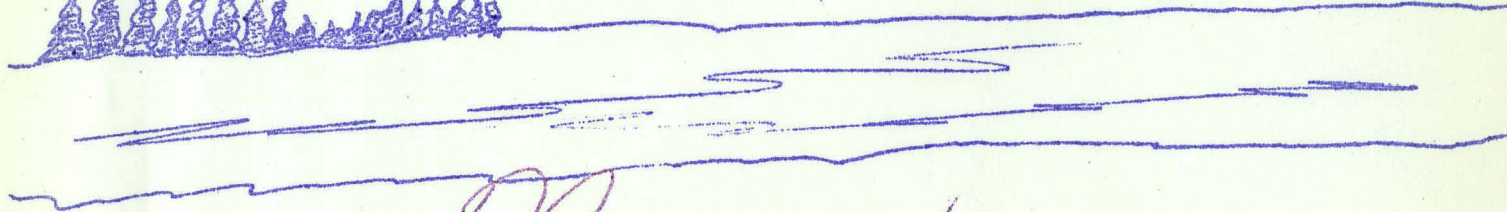
them? Yes, it is so easy! Jesus made it easy.

The official inspection party has come and gone. They did not appear disappointed in our hospital.

However we must not relax our efforts simply because some people have been discharged. Our concern is with those still in hospital. They will have to keep up the struggle against their disease and they will not be discharged until their battle is won.

Consequently our advise is the same as before, namely observe routine carefully and obey the nurses instantly. If you, on routine I, stay in bed all the time, you will get better. Remember if you are placed in a plaster cast it is unpleasant for YOU yourselves. It doesn't affect the rest of us in the least.

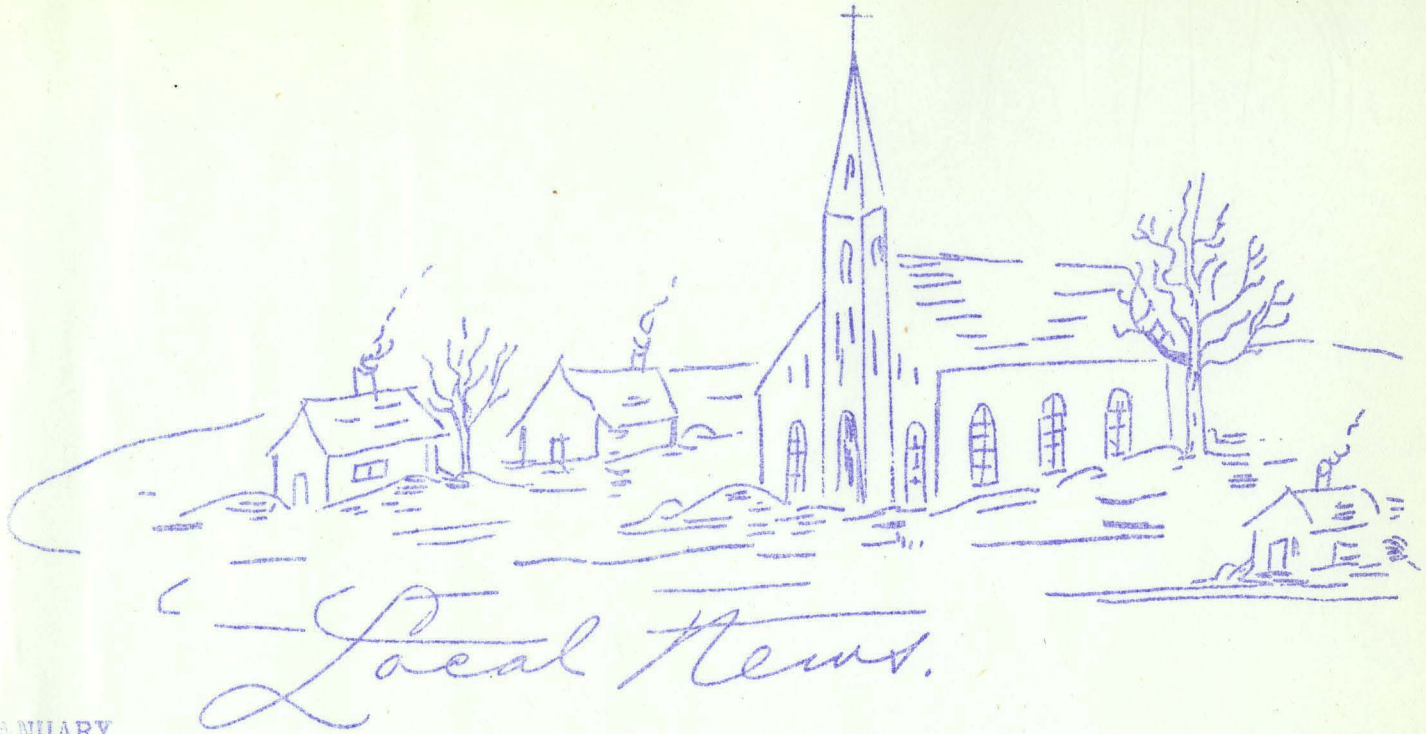
We are doing good, I am

Remember the QUEEN to reign over our first Winter Carnival depends on your vote.

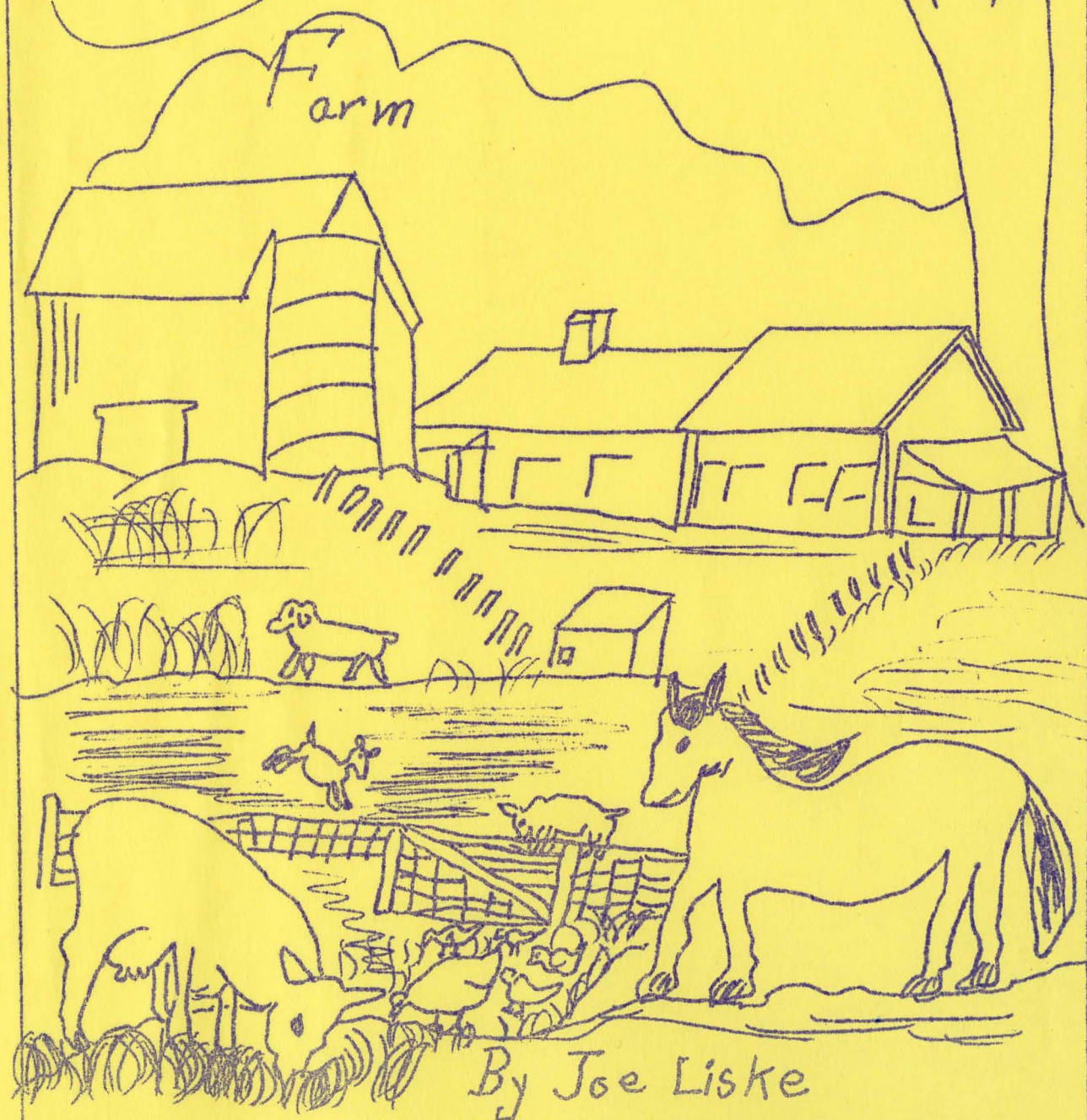
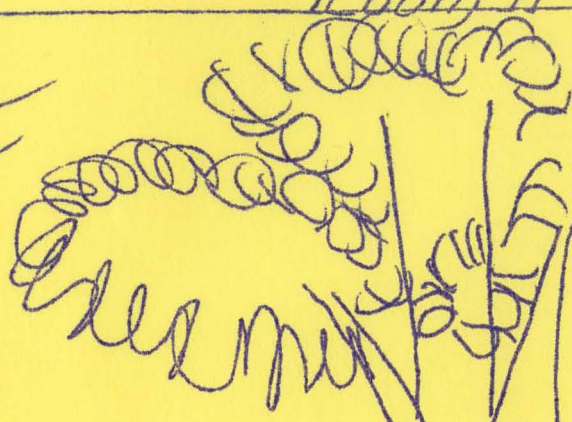

FRANCE Guy Mollet premier of France! During the German occupation
 ----- of France, World War II, the Gestapo arrested Guy Mollet,
 but released him. They thought he looked too mild to be an important

Who made the birds that sing?

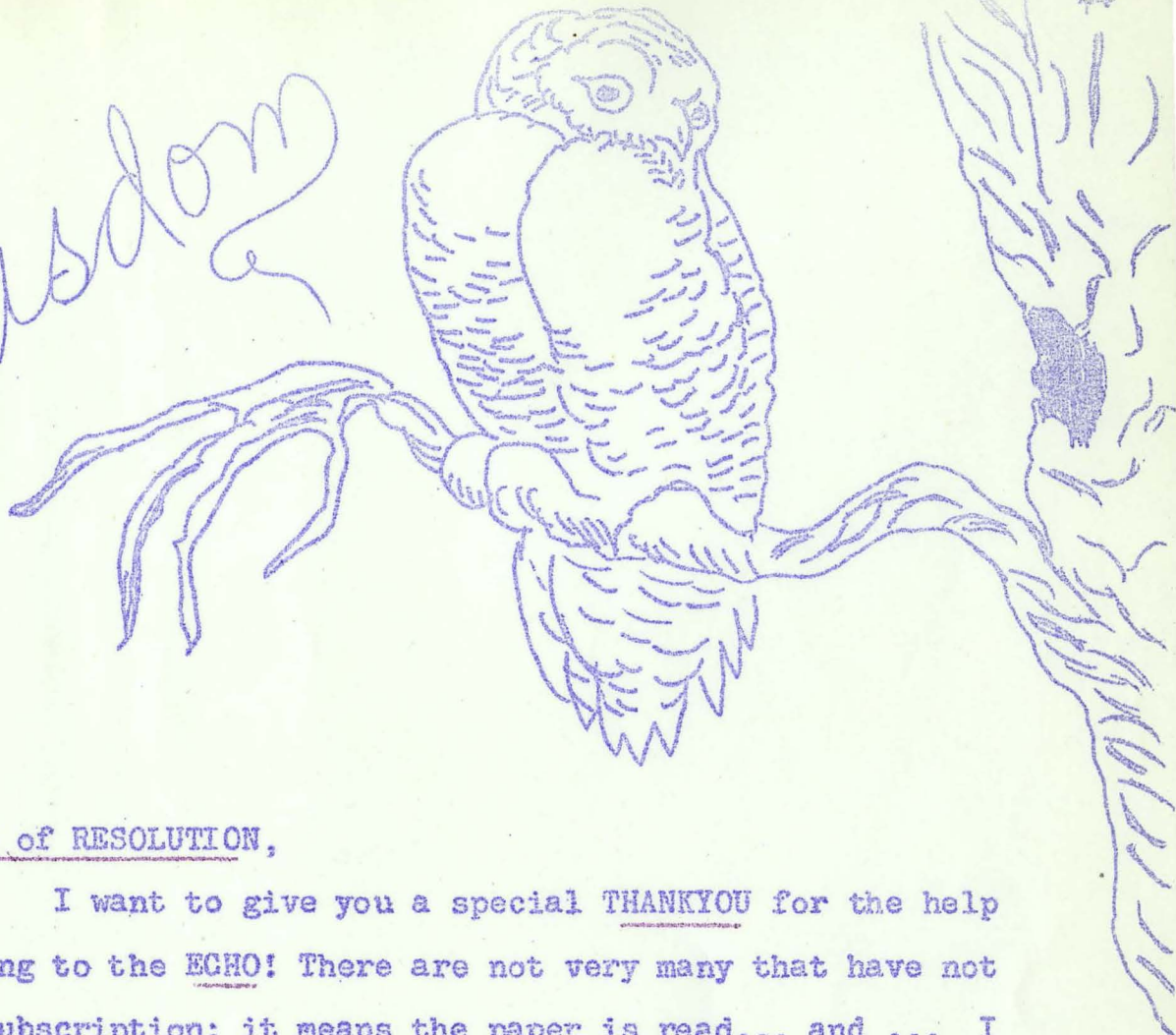
The laughing brook, the tinkling stream

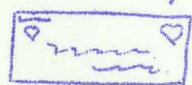

A turn-ing of the win-dow blinds, That all may feel the air.



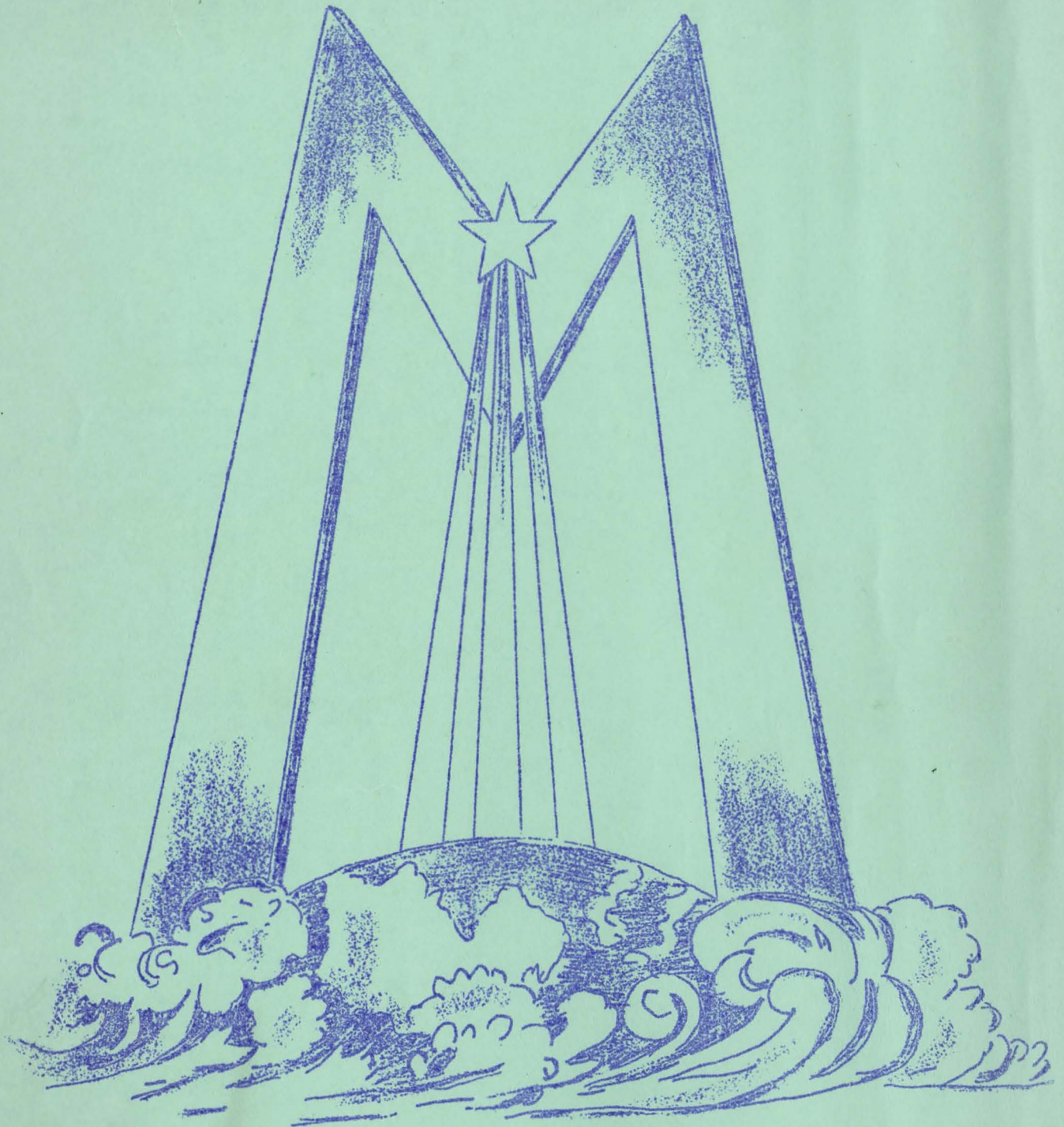
