The pupils at the Algoma Indian Homes wear one style of uniform—dark navy blue, trimmed with red, and brass buttons.

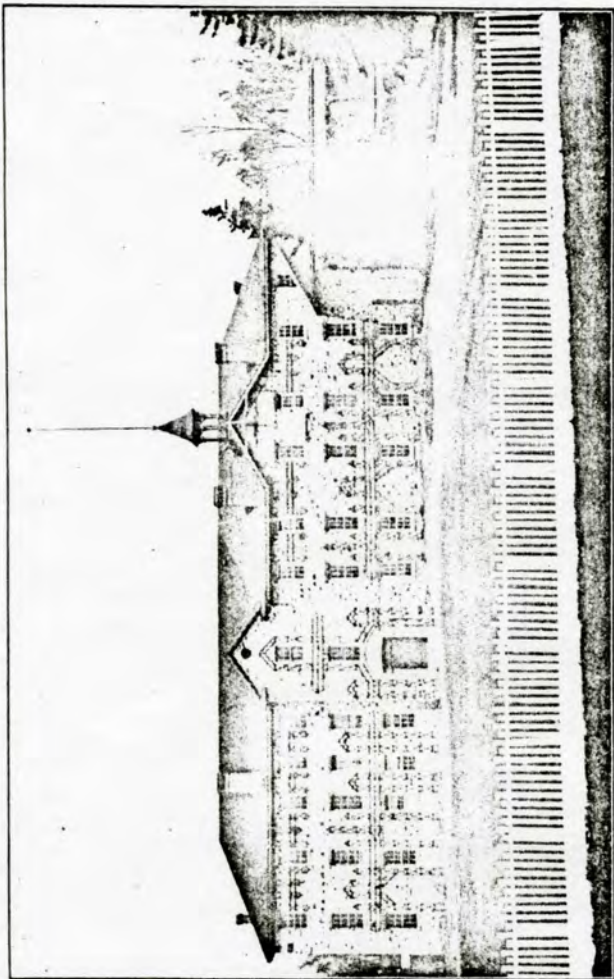

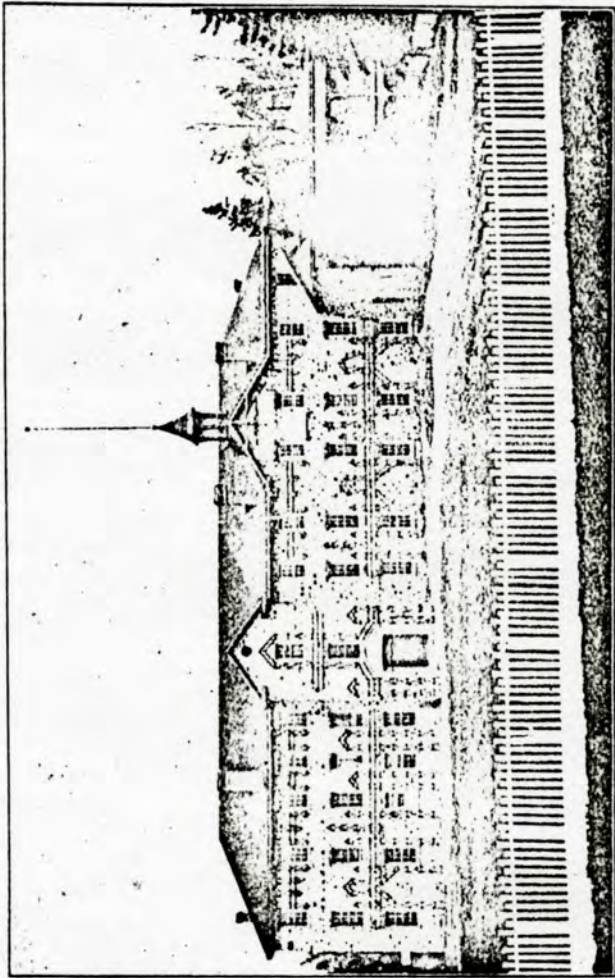
