In June of 2008, Prime Minister Stephan Harper issued an official "Statement of apology to former students of Indian Residential Schools." In September of 2009, he delivered a speech at the G20 in which he stated in reference to Canada that, "we also have no history of Colonialism."

'(official denial) trade value in progress' appropriates the latter statement as a springboard for critical exchange. A set of books and a textile piece made up of a composite of Hudson Bay blankets with this statement machine-sewn in the centre act as a platform for response and dialogue.



The project invites people to respond to Stephen Harper's statement of denial. When the project is presented in public people can contribute their response to the project book. In Sewing Actions participants hand-sew collected responses onto the blanket and can also contribute a response to the books.
