

Tentative Install Schedule

Day 1: Introductory circle with the volunteers. Moving boxes and opening the boxes (not removing the vamps). Beginning to install the cloth on the floor. Closing circle.

Day 2: Opening circle. Completing the install of the clothing, taping any edges that may be tripping hazards. Placing the yarn lines in place approx.. 7.5" apart in rows. Placing the boxes of vamps down along the path and beginning the installation of vamps. Closing circle.

Day 3: Opening circle. Continuing placement of vamps and adjustments to lines. Any special areas for the Eagle Staffs will be getting done. Trading out pairs and making sure the accurate adjustments and fine tuning is made. Using the brushes and lint tables. Closing Circles.

Day 4: Opening circle. Continuing with placement of vamps as needed. Setting up the volunteer tables, carpets, merchandise area, and contemplation area for visitors. Placing signage in space and around school about exhibit. Closing circle.

Day 5: Opening circle. Final day of install is for doing fine adjustments and cleaning. Final set up of everything. Organizing boxes and shipping materials. Everything should be times so that two hours prior to the end of the day everyone is on hands and knees with rollers to clean the path for the opening. No vamps should be touched once they are in their final placement. Elder or Keeper smudges the space as "if the women are standing in their moccasins." Closing circle.
