Core Committee Roles We Need Help With:

Communications—Social Media (2 people)

- Updating facebook and twitter with photographs, videos and comments throughout the installation, exhibit, and take-down process.
- Sending video and photographs to the national collective

Communications—Print (1 person)

- Distribution of print materials including posters, handouts, and signage.
- Working with larger communications team

Finances (2 people)

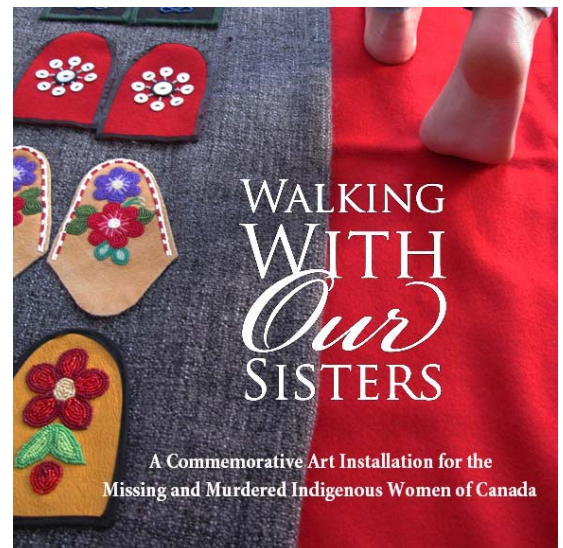
- Overseeing donations made to WWOS and sale of merchandise during WWOS
- Maintains sale records and cash boxes throughout WWOS.
- Uses simple accounting templates provided by WWOS.

Volunteer Coordinators (2 people)

- Scheduling volunteers
- Contacting volunteers to remind them of upcoming shifts
- Helping organize volunteer orientation and helping with volunteer recruitment

Youth Coordinator (1 person)

- Scheduling visiting youth and school groups
- Organizing youth sharing circles and other youth specific events
- Working with national youth coordinator.

Exhibit Installation (April 30th to May 4th).

- Flexible hours, you can sign up for a couple of hours or full days.
- Helping to prepare the Shingwauk Auditorium for WWOS and the installation of the vamps in the space.
- Refreshments will be provided to volunteers who sign up for long shifts.

Exhibit Helpers (May 5th to May 18th).

- Greeting and welcoming visitors to WWOS.
- Keeping visitor and sale numbers using simple charts.
- Flexible hours, you can sign up for a couple of hours or longer shifts.

Exhibit Take Down (May 19th to 22nd)

- Helping de-install the exhibit and packing the vamps to travel to the next community.
- Flexible hours, you can sign up for a couple of hours or full days.
