Of the 4 competing productions, Theatre Algoma took 5 of the 13 awards. The adjudicator had high praise for the director's "vision" and called the show an "heroic undertaking"

but objected to the director's "risk taking."

Awards included best actor, best visual presentation, best technical achievement, best youth achievement, and best stage management (to Jane Capstick)."







- 3. Kirk Lee Banjoko as Zastrozzi's henchman, Bernardo.




